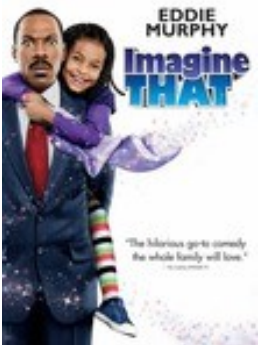

PG-13, 109 minutes

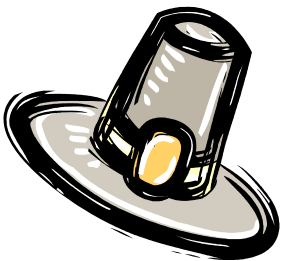
