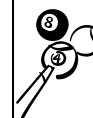

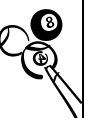

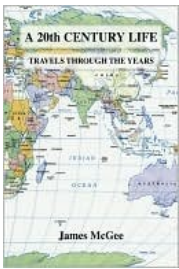


Flu Shots
